Bills Committee on Public Health and Municipal Services (Amendment) Bill Meeting on 4 December

The Hong Kong College of Community Medicine (the College) would like to send in a written submission on the proposed Public Health and Municipal Services (Amendment) Bill as follows.

As a professional organisation consisting of specialist doctors working to improve the health of the community, the College supports the proposed introduction of Public Health and Municipal Services (Amendment) Bill 2008 to better protect the health of the people in Hong Kong.

We note that it is proposed to empower the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene (DFEH) to make orders administratively to prohibit the import and supply of any food and direct that any food supplied be recalled in the manner specified in the order, if DFEH has reasonable grounds to believe that the making of the order is necessary to prevent or reduce the possibility of a danger to public health or to mitigate any adverse consequence of a danger to public health. DFEH has to take into consideration various factors in deciding whether there are reasonable grounds to make the order. We also note that information including the particulars of the food, reason for making the

order, the prohibition or action required of the traders, etc. will be clearly stated when an order is made by DFEH.
