Banking of OM Part I Examination

If a candidate gets a clear pass in one paper but fails in the other paper and gets a total score of at least the pass mark for the two papers (i.e. 50% of the total marks), s/he will be allowed to carry-over the passed paper, but s/he must re-sit the failed paper and pass it in the next available examination. Otherwise, s/he will have to re-sit the whole Part I examination.

Banking takes immediate effect, and also has retrospective effect on the Part I examination held in June 2006.
