The Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH) is a 976 bed general, tertiary referral teaching hospital with a number of specialities including medicine, surgery, orthopaedics, psychiatry, oncology and trauma services. Located at Herston and close to the central business district of Brisbane, the RBWH has an operating budget of approximately \$590 million and has recently undergone a major redevelopment program. The majority of the hospital clinical services have been rebuilt at a total cost of approximately \$510 million, making it the largest hospital redevelopment in Australia's history.

Reporting to the Executive Director of Medical Services, the Deputy Executive Director of Medical Services will communicate with all levels of medical staff and health service providers & health related organisations to provide specialised medical administrative support and direction to clinical services at the RBWH. This will involve; liaising to ensure the recruitment, appointment, credentialing and employment of professional staff is consistent with policy, legislation and Award provisions, monitoring of clinical outcomes and standards, and active participation in safety and quality activities. Additionally you will represent the Executive Director of Medical Services on Queensland Health, Hospital and Service committees as required, and provide relief and support for this position as required.

It is essential that the successful candidate possess an MBBS or equivalent qualifications and be registered, or eligible for registration, with the Medical Board Queensland. They must also possess administrative postgraduate qualifications, or be currently studying towards an administrative qualification, ideally Fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Medical Administrators.
