#### **Rules for Abstract Submission**

- Abstracts should be submitted using the electronic <u>Abstract Form</u> and received by <u>16 July</u> <u>2012(Defer to 31 July 2012)</u>.
- 2. Organise the body of the abstract as follows:
  - state the purpose of the study (preferably one sentence);
  - describe the methods used;
  - summarise the results;
  - · state the conclusions reached.
  - Work in progress is also acceptable
- 3. Abstracts should not exceed 350 words. Extra words would be edited without further notice.
- 4. Use standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full term the first time it appears. Use Arabic numerals to indicate numbers, except at the beginning of a sentence.
- 5. Presenter must register for the Scientific Meeting.
- 6. Submit the completed Abstract Form electronically to: Secretariat, Annual Scientific Meeting, Room 908, 9/F., HKAMJC Building, 99 Wong Chuk Hang Road, Aberdeen, Hong Kong. Please send the soft copy (in Arial Font 11) by e-mail to yandy\_hkccm@hkam.org.hk
