Rules for Abstract Submission

1. Abstracts should be submitted using the electronic Abstract Form and received by **28 July 2013** (Extended to 11 August 2013).
2. Organise the body of the abstract as follows :
 - state the purpose of the study (preferably one sentence);
 - describe the methods used;
 - summarise the results;
 - state the conclusions reached.
 - Work in progress is also acceptable
3. Abstracts should not exceed 350 words. Extra words would be edited without further notice.
4. Use standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full term the first time it appears. Use Arabic numerals to indicate numbers, except at the beginning of a sentence.
5. Presenter must register for the Scientific Meeting.
6. Submit the completed Abstract Form electronically to: Secretariat, Annual Scientific Meeting, Room 908, 9/F., HKAMJC Building, 99 Wong Chuk Hang Road, Aberdeen, Hong Kong. Please send the soft copy (in Arial Font 11) by e-mail to yandy_hkccm@hkam.org.hk
