- 7. The Director of Audit's Report on Regulatory Control of Private Hospitals (2012) highlighted the need to revamp the outdated Hospitals, Nursing Homes and Maternity Homes Registration Ordinance (Cap. 165), and commented on the inadequacies of current effort in regulating private hospitals. In response, the government's Working Group on Regulation of Private Hospitals discussed the following areas with suggestions to tighten regulation and licensing requirements:
  - Power of regulatory authority
  - Corporate governance requirements
  - Clinical governance requirements
  - Hospital accreditation requirements
  - Price transparency requirements
  - Sentinel event reporting requirements
  - Complaint handling system requirements

Choose any 5 items from the above. Discuss and explain how such enhancements may affect the achievement of system goals such as Effectiveness, Quality and Safety, and Acceptability/Satisfaction.
