Submissions are welcome in all topics related to the following.

- this year's theme
- community medicine

Abstract for Oral Presentation

Abstracts should be structured into the following logical sequence:

- An abstract title (The title should not exceed 25 words)
- Background
- Problem or Issues to Discuss
- Methods / data analysis/quality initiative/
- Results /Findings/Measures
- Conclusion/ Lesson learn
- References/Acknowledgements

Abstracts must be submitted in English.

Abstract Submission Form should be typed in Arial 11-point font size with single-line spacing. Handwritten abstracts will NOT be accepted.

Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full term the first time it appears.

The length of the abstract is *not more than 350 words*, excluding authors' details and headers title. EXAMPLE

SMOKING OR HEALTH: WHAT SHOULD BE THE NEXT STEPS IN THE PREVENTION OF TOBACCO RELATED DISEASES IN HONG KONG

Abstract can only be submitted by completing the submission form, which can be downloaded from www.hkccm.org.hk or obtained from the College Secretariat via hkccm@hkam.org.hk, and return to the College Secretariat by e-mail.

Submission by fax or courier will not be accepted. No exemption will be made.

Submitted abstracts will be examined by members of the Scientific Committee upon quality, clarity, and relevance for the audience, as well as the significance of the paper.

Accepted abstracts must be presented in the form of Oral Presentation at the Scientific Meeting on scheduled date and time. Presentation schedule will be emailed 2 weeks before scheduled.

Abstract acceptance notifications will be sent via e-mail. Presenter MUST register for the Scientific Meeting.

Each presentation should be no more than 12 minutes in duration with 3 minutes additionally for questions and answers. Adherence to the time limit will be strictly observed to ensure the efficient running of the proceedings.

Please submit a soft copy of your slides (a maximum of 12 slides ONLY) to the College Secretariat on or before <u>17 September 2021</u>.
