The College Council extends its sincere gratitude and appreciation to two esteemed members who stepped down after the Annual General Meeting: **Dr Chung Wai Hung Thomas** and **Dr Chiu Pui Yin Amy**. Their dedication, invaluable service, and commitment to the College's mission have been instrumental in our progress, and we honor their contributions with deep respect and appreciation. We also hope that they will continue to support the College in other meaningful ways, sharing their wisdom and experience with our community.

During the AGM, the following special resolutions were passed:

1. Revision to the Definition of Associate Fellow

The removal of the requirement for completion of the period of training in community medicine for Associate Fellow membership, while retaining the requirement to pass the intermediate examination prescribed in the by-laws.



2. Revision of Annual Subscription Fees, and Waiver of ASM Registration Fee

With effect from 1 October 2026, the Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) registration fee shall be permanently waived for all Members in good standing. This represents a significant benefit to our membership and reflects the College's commitment to supporting professional development and knowledge exchange among our community.

Revised Fee Structure (Effective 1 October 2026):

Membership Category	Annual Subscription Fee (HKD)
Fellow	4,600
Associate Fellow	2,800
Associate Member	1,700
Affiliate Fellow	1,500
Affiliate Member	1,400

Important Notes:

1. Annual subscription is due on 1 October each year and covers a 12-month period ending 30 September of the following year. Members admitted between 1 October and 31 March pay the full subscription; those admitted between 1 April and 30 September pay half.
2. **Retired Members:** Annual subscription is at 25% of the standard rate for the respective local membership category. Written application to the College Secretariat is required, confirming retirement from all remunerative practice/job/business.
3. **Members Residing Overseas:** Annual subscription is at 50% of the standard rate for the respective local membership category. For retired members residing overseas, the rate is 12.5% of the standard rate.
4. **Fellows Aged Over 65:** Annual subscription is at 25% of the Fellow subscription rate. Written application with a copy of Hong Kong Identity Card is required.
